



### Regular Maintenance

1. Vacuum, sweep, or dry mop regularly to prevent loose dirt or grit from scratching your floor's finish. A dust mop with terry cloth or microfiber cover is highly recommended.
2. Spray the hard surface cleaner onto the damp cloth or microfiber mop cover. Use the mop to thoroughly clean the floor surface. Finish one area before moving on to the next. When your cleaning pad becomes soiled, rinse it with water and wring out thoroughly before you continue cleaning. If the pad becomes excessively soiled, replace it with a clean one to avoid streaking.

### Preventative Maintenance

- Spills and tracked-in dirt should be wiped up immediately. For spot cleaning, apply your hard surface cleaner onto a clean cloth and rub onto the spot. **Do not allow excess cleaner or water to remain on the floor's surface.**
- Use interior and exterior doormats at all entrances to collect dirt and moisture and prevent it from being tracked onto the floor. Area rugs are recommended in front of kitchen sinks, at all pivot points and within high-traffic areas.
- Never use any of the following products (or products similar in nature) on your floor: ammonia-based cleaners, acrylic finishes, wax-based products, detergents, bleach, polishes, oil soap, abrasive cleaning soaps, or acidic materials such as vinegar. Many of these products can pit or etch the finish of your flooring or prevent the proper use of recommended maintenance materials.
- Marks and stubborn stains can easily be removed with acetone nail polish remover or other mild, solvents containing alcohol.
- Do not roll or slide heavy objects directly upon the floor. When moving appliances or heavy furniture, consider laying a solid protective covering on your floor and gently "walk" the item across it. Carpet or cardboard is not adequate to prevent surface compression scratches.
- Use furniture leg protector pads under all furniture and make certain to keep them clean and well maintained. Replace hard, narrow furniture rollers with wide rubber rollers.
